Do Children's Lives Matter?

- Cost of drug abuse...\$1 Trillion a year! (Source: Psychology Today)
- Cost of human trafficking, average age 13...\$32 Billion a year! (Source: Human Rights First)
- Cost of youth suicide...\$58.4 Billion a year! (Source: Americashealthrankings.org)

We must discuss the high cost to families and taxpayers. So how can we demonstrate that *Children's Lives Matter*?

Americans Are Witnessing A Spiritual Crisis

Politicians, community leaders, and citizens must put children first! We don't allow children to bullying in schools, so why are city leaders allowing bullies to injure 400+ police officers and destroy public and private property without condemning their actions?
